SUBJECT: Case Closeout, #I00070011

1. This case was initiated on July 13, 2000 as an investigation based on information provided by [REDACTED] Office of Polar Programs. The allegation involved an incident of unauthorized computer intrusion of the United States Antarctic Program (USAP) servers, located at the Amundsen-Scott South Pole Station.
2. [REDACTED] Network Engineer and Security Analyst, [REDACTED] and the Office of Inspector General (OIG) investigated the allegation. [REDACTED] submitted the required Federal Computer Incident Response Capability (FedCIRC) Incident Reporting Form.
3. [REDACTED] took general systems precautionary measures with assistance from [REDACTED], NSF/OIG.
4. In a memo dated May 05, 2000, OIG requested specific information technology recommendations from [REDACTED] Technology Development Manager, [REDACTED]. A response regarding those recommendations was received on September 19, 2000. No further OIG action is being taken at this time.
