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On 9/21/01, the Chief of Accounting Operations-NSF contacted OIG. He communicated information he received from [REDACTED] regarding a computer [REDACTED] shipped from [REDACTED] to NSF. The computer, according to [REDACTED] was ordered on 8/21 and shipped to NSF on 8/27/01. [REDACTED] placed a hold on the computer awaiting verification from NSF, i.e., whether it belonged to us.

An Investigator w/ [REDACTED] confirmed that the computer at the [REDACTED] was part of invoice [REDACTED]. I then contacted the AO who was listed on the invoice and she provided me with a copy of invoice [REDACTED] which listed 3 computers. I personally inspected all 3 computers (and 1 additional computer purchased through invoice [REDACTED]) and noted their serial numbers.

NSF ordered four computers and received four computers. NSF property was not stolen or diverted. I have called [REDACTED] to notify them of our finding and also called [REDACTED] to inform them that the computer at the Pawn Shop is not one of NSF's computers even if [REDACTED] records indicate it was shipped to NSF. I have also called the Chief of Accounting Operations and informed him that there was no theft of NSF property.

This case is closed.
