Our office received an allegation in February 1993 from a former employee and co-PI on an NSF grant, Dr. He alleged that his former supervisor and PI on an NSF grant, Dr. had fired him in retaliation for Dr. complaints about grant expenditure and his intent to speak to NSF officials regarding this. We found no evidence of personal benefit from any misuse of grant funds. Furthermore, OIG-Oversight reviewed the allegation of scientific misconduct and issued no findings.

Since our initial review (May 4, 1993), we have received no additional evidence to cause us to reconsider our initial determination. This case is closed.
