The NASA-OIG referred an allegation to us that NSF Program Officer [REDACTED] may have received improper travel reimbursement from the [REDACTED]. The [REDACTED] is a not-for-profit science foundation that supports science in the former [REDACTED]. NSF And [REDACTED] have agreed to cooperate on related matters dealing with science in the former [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is a Collaborative Activities Program Director in the Division of Networking and Communications Research and Infrastructure.

We reviewed [REDACTED] travel records and found that [REDACTED] has paid travel expenses for [REDACTED] travel to the former [REDACTED]. The review also determined that [REDACTED] received the appropriate supervisory and OGC approval for the [REDACTED] funded travel. We reviewed [REDACTED] time and attendance records to ensure that [REDACTED] was not taking leave while on travel paid by [REDACTED] and not personally benefiting from the [REDACTED] funded travel. The review showed that [REDACTED] did not take leave during [REDACTED] funded travel. [REDACTED] as stated that all travel was for official business and was approved by his supervisors and OGC, and that his official duties while on travel funded by [REDACTED] are consistent with the agreement between NSF and ISF.

The investigation has found no violations of statute or regulation. This case is closed.
