NSF And have agreed to cooperate on related matters dearing with science in the former is a Collaborative Activities Program Director in the Division of Networking and Communications Research and Infrastructure.

We reviewed that travel records and found that has paid travel expenses for travel to the former. The review also determined that received the appropriate supervisory and OGC approval for the funded travel. We reviewed time and attendance records to ensure that has not taking leave while on travel paid by and not personally benefiting from the funded travel. The review showed that had all travel was for official business and was approved by his supervisors and OGC, and that his official duties while on travel funded by the are consistent with the agreement between NSF and ISF.

The investigation has found no violations of statute or regulation. This case is closed.
