SUBJECT: Allegation of improper [REDACTED]

On May 10, 1994 we received an allegation from National Science Foundation (NSF) employee [REDACTED] of improper [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] is a member of the [REDACTED] currently assigned to Conference Services, Division of Administrative Services (DAS). Mr. [REDACTED] believed his [REDACTED] had been improperly accessed by his supervisor, [REDACTED] and the Division Chief of Conference Services, [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that on April 18, 1994 he found a note on his monitor telling him to change his [REDACTED] password. Mr. [REDACTED] spoke with the postmaster who told him his mailbox had needed to be moved. Mr. [REDACTED] inquired about the matter through [REDACTED] DAS. Ms. [REDACTED] told him that access to his [REDACTED] had been granted to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] by the postmaster.

On May 12, 1994 I spoke with postmasters [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and Section Head [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] remembered moving Mr. [REDACTED] mailbox because of a system error. Access to Mr. [REDACTED] was not given to anyone.

As we found no evidence to substantiate the allegation of improper access to [REDACTED] further investigation of the allegation is not warranted at this time.

This case is closed.
