SUBJECT: Thefts from [REDACTED] Facility

On June 3, 1994, we received a complaint from [REDACTED], the [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] facility. [REDACTED] reported that since opening in mid-April there have been numerous thefts of small amounts of food from the kitchen and eatery areas of the facility. On May 31, 1994, [REDACTED] contacted DAS to report the problems. On June 23, 1994, DAS changed the lock on the rear (service) entrance to the facility. However, the thefts continued.

On July 1, 1994, we contacted DAS and discussed the possibility of increased security measures. DAS agreed to increase security measures and on July 5, 1994, the locks on the two front entrances to the facility were changed and a buzzer was installed on the service entrance. In addition, on September 2, 1994, DAS notified OIG that the maintenance crew no longer has access to the facility and [REDACTED] has asked several of her employees to leave.

[REDACTED] reports that since July 6, 1994 the thefts have ceased. Further investigation is not warranted at this time and no further action is necessary.

This case is closed.
