Pursuant to an anonymous request, we investigated Grant No. determine whether NSF funds were being used to improperly reimburse a Principal Investigator for international travel. Specifically, on 6-20-96, this office received a facsimile transmission from an anonymous source, which suggested that NSF funds were being used to improperly support a grantee's "vacation." The facsimile included a letter from the Principal Investigator on the above-referenced grant, requesting that travel funds and salary be paid from the NSF grant, for grant-related research to be performed in Germany.

Upon review of the grant file, we determined that , Program Director for the approved the request for funds by a memorandum to the grant file dated 5-16-95. This memo was faxed to advising him that a written request was needed. By correspondence dated 5-23-95, Dr. Director of the Sponsored Programs, formally requested that traver and salary funds be authorized for research in Germany.
