On July 1, 1997, our office received an anonymous letter citing various allegations against Dr. an NSF principal investigator (PI) at the The complainant(s) alleged that the had sent nearly identical proposals to various federal agencies and received funding for these proposals. They also alleged that sed travel funds for unnecessary trips, and takes his wife to conferences and dinners at the expense of sponsors.

I reviewed NSF grants from 1992 to present - and and second 2. The former is a current grant. In the current and pending the support section of this proposal, Miller did not include his EPA grant no. but he did make reference to this in the body of the proposal. It is possible that it's exclusion in the section might have been an oversight and not intentional. In reviewing the section for section, there was no evidence of any other grants, federal or non-federal, peing excluded from this section.

I reviewed a list of current and closed grants for the past three years from federal and non-federal sources. I reviewed EPA grant no. See and found no duplication to NSF proposals.

For the current NSF grant, the chas submitted only 1 travel voucher for a trip to the Fall 1996 Meeting in San Francisco, CA. I found no evidence of third party reimbursements or non-grant related charges, i.e. for providing the wife, or other types of fraud from this travel voucher and source documentation. Internal audit has decided to inquire as to why the expenses for this trip were divided between two of the effect grants (NSF and EPA).

There is no evidence which supports the allegations received by this office. At this time, this case is closed.
