SUBJECT: Case Closeout, #I97090050

- 1. The Defense Criminal Investigative Service (DCIS) in conjunction with the Office of Inspector General, National Science Foundation (OIG-NSF) investigated an allegation involving fraud.
- 2. The investigation revealed that the President, and Vice President, were involved in altering resumes of staff in order to become more competitive for grant/contract proposals. previously submitted a proposal to NSF utilizing the fraudulent resumes.
- 3. The case was presented for prosecution to the United States Attorney's Office, which accepted the case. It pled guilty to three counts and pled guilty to two counts of Major Fraud against the United States, in violation of Title 18 USC § 1031. Sentencing took place on January 26, 2001, in the United States District Court, Eastern District of Virginia. Was sentenced to five months with the United States Bureau of Prisons and fined \$70,769. Was sentenced to eight months in community confinement, and fined \$36,326.
- 4. This investigation is closed and no further action is being taken by OIG at this time.
