1. On 12 April 1999, this office received information from [REDACTED] alleging that [REDACTED] was publicly "smearing" him. [REDACTED] alleged that [REDACTED] was using his NSF computer, fax machine, and Internet access to obtain publicly-available information regarding [REDACTED]'s military records. [REDACTED] then placed the information he received on car windshields at the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post in [REDACTED] MD, where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are members.
2. [REDACTED] documents to the OIG which he retrieved from the car windshields at the VFW. These documents included, in part, three letters from [REDACTED] to various Department of Defense components. All three letters provided [REDACTED]'s home address and two list his NSF e-mail address. The third letter appears to have been faxed from an NSF fax machine.
3. On 26 July 1999, this information was referred to the Employee Relations Branch, IRM/HRM.
4. On 2 November 1999, [REDACTED] Chief, IRM/HRM advised that they would not take disciplinary action against [REDACTED].
